Professor Daniel Mills

Daniel is a pioneer in the field of clinical animal behaviour in the UK and he was the first individual to be recognised by the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons as a specialist in veterinary behavioural medicine.

He led the development of the MSc in Clinical Animal Behaviour at the University of Lincoln, where he has also helped establish one of the largest research groups. He has produced hundreds of research publications to deepen our understanding of companion animal behaviour and its management as well as human animal relationships.

Covering three key topics, Daniel will firstly highlight the role of pain in a range of behaviour problems, before tackling the issue of social organisation in dogs and the emotional basis to aggressive behaviour.
