## Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April 6.00-9.15pm 'Lets get Hands-on!'

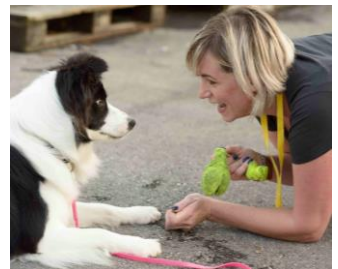
