Our guest presenter Sue McCabe will delve into the understanding of 'how it feels' and how to manage the emotions involved in living with and training a puppy, from the perspective of instructors, owners and dogs. This instructors workshop will combine theory and practical learning, covering subjects such as expectations versus reality in dog ownership, conditioned emotional responses and how they impact on training, and common emotional challenges of frustration and trust. It also offers limited opportunities for handlers to partake in fun games and training exercises which explore the emotions that influence both the human and the dog.
