<p>I have been instructing for over 25 years but have trained dogs for over 40 in obedience, breed and agility as well as training simply for a good companion. I show, breed and judge and I am a KC Show Judge at Championship Level for Papillons and Chihuahuas</p> <p>I personally have owned and lived with a wide variety of dogs from GSD's to many Papillons and Chihuahuas in a multi, multi-dog household. I currently live with 28 as well as one or two in for rescue, as I also work as a breed rescue co-ordinator for Papillons and run North West Small dog Rescue. I take in, re-hab and re-home mostly Paps, but I do find myself taking a few other breeds on occasions.</p> <p>We opened our own dedicated training centre in May 2009 after constantly trying to find new venues for different classes and finding dogs not welcome. We run 5 days of play care and 4 nights plus Saturday mornings of training and agility per week.</p> <p>I acted as external assessor for the PDTI in 2011 and ran 2 back to back workshops on Ring Craft. I sat for, and passed the Harper Adams University College exam for the Level 4 Certificate in Canine Behaviour and Training. I have taken my formal academic studies to Level 4 so far, but I continually research and expand my knowledge in keeping up to date. I have gained membership of several membership bodies, having been assessed for my various practical skills</p> <p>My life is dedicated to dogs, both my own and other peoples.
