<p>I have been involved with rescue dog work for 35 years and often taking in dogs difficult to re-home. Beginning in 1978 as a volunteer for the RSPCA and Hon. Secretary for Banbury, to my current position of Trustee (Sec) and Rescue Co-ordinator of the Old English Sheepdog Rescue &amp; Welfare; a registered charity.</p> <p>I was 11 years old before I was allowed a dog of my own; a rescue Springer Spaniel who certainly taught me a lot! To be a good dog trainer today, it's not enough to have a passion or to have grown up around dogs – although you certainly need to be passionate about them. My own qualifications mean that I have been assessed both in my theoretical knowledge and practical teaching skills by recognised organisations in training and behaviour.</p> <p>The PDTI has helped and encouraged me to improve and widen my skills and complete the Harper Adams University Diploma. I am also a provisional member of the United Kingdom Registry of Canine Behaviourists. I am currently working towards my Kennel Club Accredited Instructors Award in Companion Dog Training, Good Citizens Dog Scheme, Breed Rescue and Behaviour.</p> <p>After many years research and working out what I wanted to teach and how, I began my own dog training business in 2006. I believe that helping people understand their dogs and creating a bond of mutual respect will help dogs to stay in their homes for life. My special areas of interest are; Safety for Children &amp; Dogs, Diet/Nutrition, Deaf Dogs, Blind Dogs, Diabetic Dogs, Problem Behaviour, Puppies and Rescue Dogs.</p> <p>My training schools are Kennel Club listed &amp; I currently run 3 schools in Northamptonshire, also covering Banbury and parts of Milton Keynes and Warwickshire for behaviour consultations.</p> <p>I run workshops for other trainers and behaviourists; the most popular being the Clicker Chicken Training days.</p> <p>In my private life, I live in rural Northamptonshire; with my husband, two dogs, twenty+ hens and around six other dogs in foster care undergoing assessments and life skill training prior to re-homing.</p>
