My latest venture is to get a Kennel Club Good Citizenship Award with a young pekingese dog, Ti Chi, which he achieved at Birmingham Championship Show. I have in the past organised eye testing sessions for dogs with Professor Peter Bedford and have worked as a veterinary nurse. I am a registered insured Microchip Implanter.
