I have instead focused on working with and improving the training and development of foster dogs from central London shelters to improve their chances of successful re-homing. I discovered Alpha when looking for support with some particularly difficult foster dogs in my care. It was impossible to ignore the significant changes in behaviour that were possible if a dog was offered the opportunity to learn and so I was bitten with the bug of learning more skills in order to increase the benefits for any dogs in my care.</p> <p>I started volunteering and assisting at Alpha in January 2013, and attended the PDTI course in July 2013, gaining my Introductory award with excellence.
